Mikvah Renovation Update



We are pleased to share that the Mikvah renovation is now in full swing. The rooms and Mikvah pool have been completely stripped, and new drywall is being installed along with the repositioning of closets and fixtures.

The Mikvah pool has been fully sealed and tested to ensure there are no leaks, as required by Jewish law, which mandates that the water remain in a still and natural state. In the coming weeks, the floor and wall tiles will be installed.

We are also excited to share that the Mikvah pool room, as well

as one of the preparation rooms, will be adorned with beautiful all-natural agate stone, adding both elegance and warmth to the space. In addition, a special Mikvah filtration system built in Israel specifically for Mikvaot has arrived and will be installed shortly.
