Pesach Shmurah Matzah, Wine and Haggadahs For Sale

In honor of the Pesach holiday, special hand-made Shmurah Matzah is available. A box of three Matzot for the Seder is available at \$20 per box, and a pound of Shmurah Matzah (approximately 6-7 Matzot) is available at \$31 per box. In addition, a Seder-To-Go Kit is available for \$49; the kit includes a Seder guide, Seeder plate placemat, labeled containers with the Seder plate items,

Hebrew/English Haggadah, three hand-made Shmurah Matzot, sweet wines, and a cute plastic frog. Although machine-made Matzah is readily available at the supermarket, many enjoy the custom of eating hand-made Shmurah Matzah at the Seder. In addition, wine choices for the Seder are available at the Chabad gift shop. The Chabad gift shop is open M-F, 9:00 am-1:00 pm.

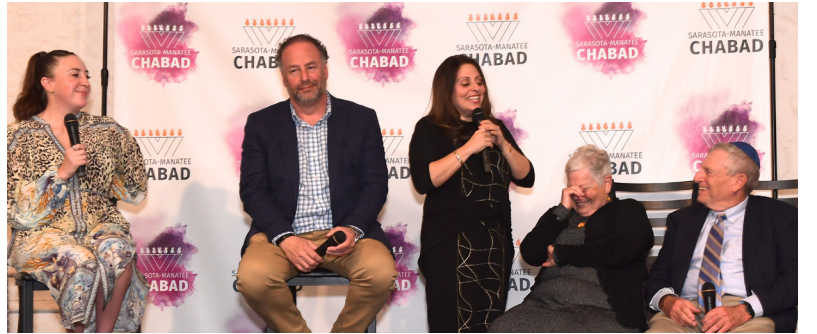

About "Seudat Moshiach" (Moshiach's Meal)

The last day of Passover ("Acharon Shel Pesach") is particularly associated with Moshiach and the future redemption. The Haftarah (reading from the Prophets) for this day is from Isaiah 11, which describes the promised future era of universal peace and divine perfection. Rabbi Israel Baal Shem Tov instituted the custom of partaking of a "Moshiach's meal" on the afternoon of the last day of Passover, in addition to the matzah eaten at "Moshiach's meal", the Rebbes of Chabad added the custom of drinking four cups of wine, as in the seder held on Passover's first day.

SELLING THE CHOMETZ

Since it is prohibited to possess chometz on Pesach, we need to sell to a non-Jew all chometz that will not be eaten or burned before Pesach, including all chometz utensils. These are stored away in closets or rooms while preparing for Pesach. Now we lock or tape shut the closets or rooms, and they are leased to the non-Jew at the time of the sale.

Since there are many legal intricacies in this sale, only a competent Rabbi should be entrusted with its execution. The Rabbi acts as our agent both to sell the chometz to the non-Jew on the morning before Pesach starts, and also to buy it back after Pesach ends.
