Joining them were Noah Rosenberg and Aleksandra Berman, both seeking a unique and special experience. The focal point of the journey was the Ohel, the final resting place of the Lubavitcher Rebbe, who assumed the mantle of leadership of Chabad-Lubavitch 74 years ago. The Rebbe, a dynamic and influential leader, left an indelible mark on Chassidim and followers alike. His teachings, expressed through talks and writings, brought forth profound inward







Ancient Wisdom, Modern Application
