PASSOVER MESSAGE FROM THE REBBE

Celebrate Your Freedom

As we celebrate Passover each year, we recall again that great event at the dawn of our history. Our people were liberated from Egyptian bondage in order to receive the Torah as free men and women.

Commenting on the verse, “And these days shall be remembered and done” (Esther 9:28), our Sages teach that as those days are remembered, they are spiritually reenacted. The Divine Benevolence that brought miracles in the past is reawakened by our act of recollection.

Passover is the “Festival of our Liberation.” It celebrates a historic event: the Exodus of the Jewish people from Egypt. However, our Sages teach us that in every generation, and on each and every day, we must see ourselves as though we have just been liberated from Egypt.

Freedom requires constant guarding. Each day, and every environment, carries its own equivalent of Egypt — a power to undermine the freedom of a Jew. Perhaps the biggest threat comes from within. The conviction that certain achievements are beyond us, the complacent belief that one was not born to reach the heights of spiritual life. To believe this is to limit oneself, to fall captive to an illusion.

Passover is thus an ongoing process of self-liberation. The festival and its practices are symbols of a struggle that is constantly renewed within a Jew, to create the freedom in which to live out his or her spiritual potential.

This is one of the reasons why we are enjoined to remember our liberation from Egypt in every generation and on every day. We must personally “go out from Egypt” every day, to escape the limits, temptations and obstructions that our physical existence places in the way of our spiritual life.

The manifestation of our liberation from Egypt is the liberation of our Divine soul from the constraints of its physical environment. And when it is achieved —with the help of G-d, who freed us from Egypt, and through a life of Torah and mizvot— a great spiritual anguish is ended. The inner conflict between what is physical and what is Divine in a Jew’s nature is transcended. Then we can enjoy real freedom, the sense of serenity and harmony, which is the prelude to freedom and peace in the world at large.

In addition, a Seder-To-Go Kit is available for \$49. The kit includes a Seder guide, Seder plate placemat, labeled containers with the Seder plate items,

Hebrew/English Haggadah, three hand-made Shmurah Matzot, sweet wines, and a cute plastic frog. Although machine-made Matzah is readily available at the supermarket, many enjoy the custom of eating hand-made Shmurah Matzah at the Seder. 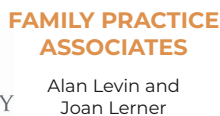
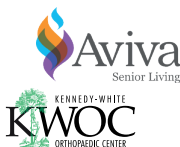

SELLING THE CHOMETZ

Since it is prohibited to possess chometz on Pesach, we need to sell to a non-Jew all chometz that will not be eaten or burned before Pesach, including all chometz utensils. These are stored away in closets or rooms while preparing for Pesach. Now we lock or tape shut the closets or rooms, and they are leased to the non-Jew at the time of the sale.

Since there are many legal intricacies in this sale, only a competent Rabbi should be entrusted with its execution. The Rabbi acts as our agent both to sell the chometz to the non-Jew on the morning before Pesach starts, and also to buy it back after Pesach ends.

About "Seudat Moshiach" (Moshiach's Meal)

The last day of Passover ("Acharon Shel Pesach") is particularly associated with Moshiach and the future redemption. The Haftarah (reading from the Prophets) for this day is from Isaiah 11, which describes the promised future era of universal peace and divine perfection. Rabbi Israel Baal Shem Tov instituted the custom of partaking of a "Moshiach's meal" on the afternoon of the last day of Passover, in addition to the matzah eaten at "Moshiach's meal", the Rebbes of Chabad added the custom of drinking four cups of wine, as in the seder held on Passover's first day.
